

### **This year's tennis camp to be held at new facility**

**ANGUILLA—The Anguilla Tennis Academy (ATA) summer camp is now in its 12<sup>th</sup> year and this year is very special as the camp will be held at the new facility at Blowing Point. Although not fully opened yet the six courts are operational and the many children who participate in the camp are looking forward to christening the courts.**

**The first two weeks of the camp that starts on July 9 will be conducted by the ATA staff led by Director Jason Allen and also visiting coaches Jonathan Collazo from Florida, and Matt Cooper from of Athens, Georgia.**

**The third and final week is the international week which will include some players from overseas as well as ten international coaches including Bill Riddle, Chris Wade, Michelle Woodruff, Siobhan Belloli, and Lance Lee.**

**The ATA camps started with a small number of children and took place on the Webster courts for the past twelve years. With 140 children participating last year it was very difficult to manage so organizers are delighted to have the new facility. Each player will participate in on court drills and match play Monday – Friday. Travis TV, will also be on hand to produce a special documentary on the camp as it has done before.**

**This year has been very significant for the ATA and much has been achieved. It is the fourth year for the after school programme and the ATA has increased its management of tennis on the island from CuisinArt to now include Malliouhana Hotel, St Regis Temenos Villas, Covecastles and Cerulean Villa.**
