

Zina Garrison to visit Anguilla

ANGUILLA—Well-known former top tennis player, Zina Garrison is to visit Anguilla from May 1 to May 7 at the invitation of the Anguilla Tennis Academy. During that time a series of tennis events and coaching will take place, centred at CuisinArt Resort where she will be staying. Garrison was one of the pioneering African American athletes of her time and during her tennis career she won 14 singles titles and 20 doubles titles.

The Anguilla Tennis Academy (ATA) is delighted to have a tennis player of her stature visit the island. During her stay she has agreed to participate in many events including the after-school tennis programme, a tour of the new ATA facility at Blowing Point. She will be giving a special clinic for top junior tennis players and for CuisinArt guests. There will be an exhibition match between Garrison and the CuisinArt and ATA Tennis Director, Jason Allen.
